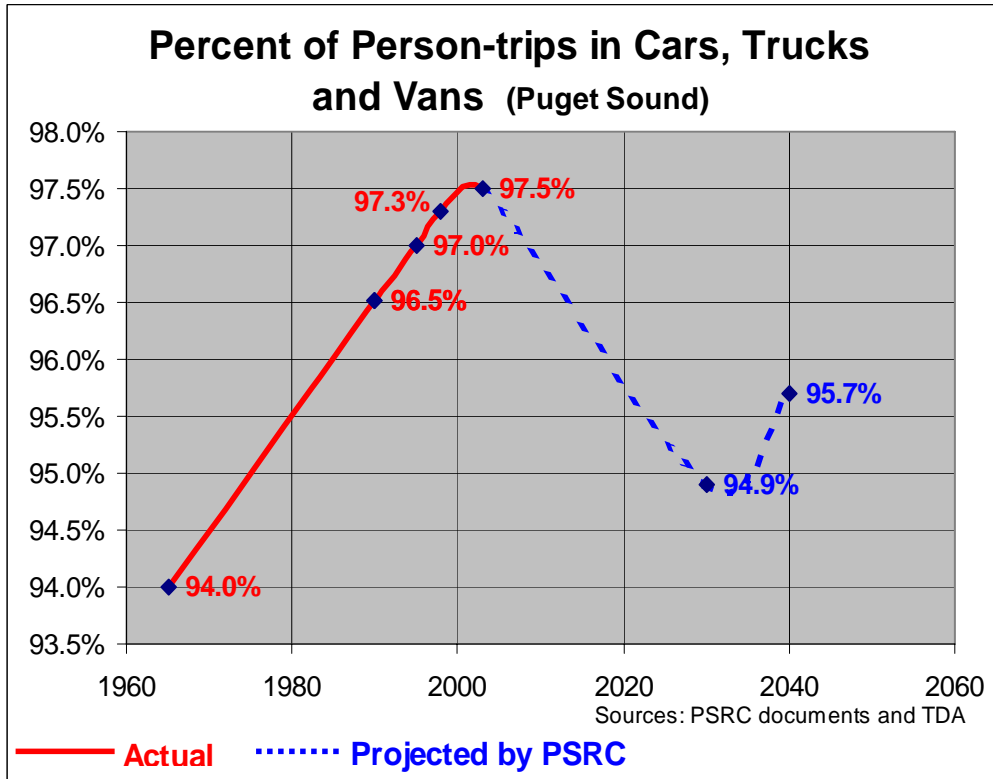


FAQ's regarding transportation in the Puget Sound Region

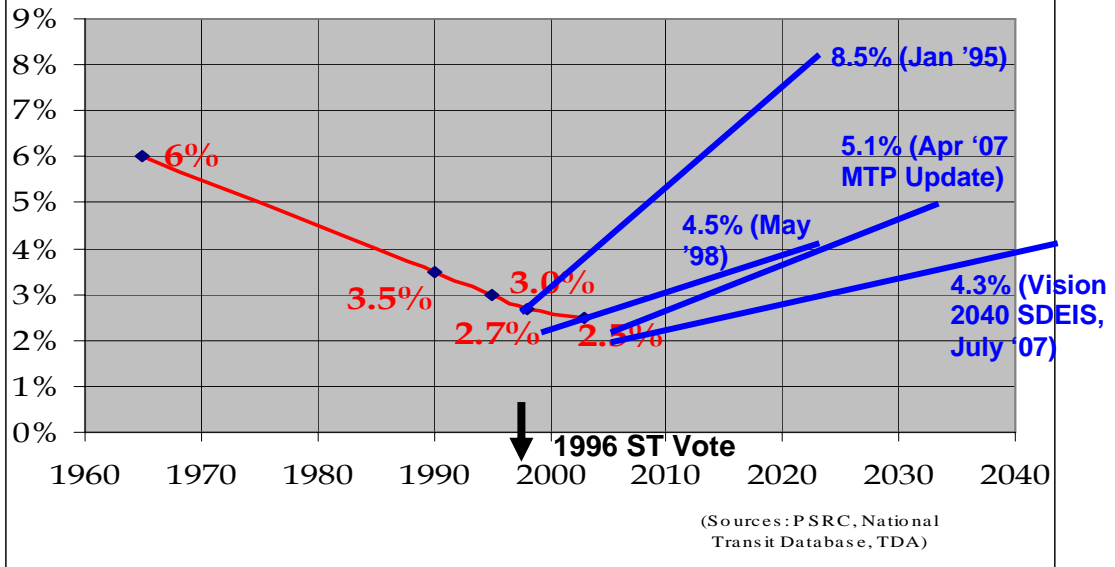
3. What is the trend in market shares for transportation over time?

In the Puget Sound region, the share of daily trips by privately-operated vehicle has been creeping up from about 94% in 1965 to almost 98% in 2002. This is similar to national patterns. In the adopted Metropolitan Transportation Plan, the Puget Sound Regional Council (PSRC) projects that this trend will reverse and return to near the 1964 level by 2030.



The trend for transit has been dramatically different having declined from about 6% of daily trips in 1965 to 2.5% in 2002. In the recently updated Metropolitan Transportation Plan, PSRC projects a reversal with an increase in transit market share to 5.1% by 2030.
